Increasing operational expenses, flat and falling federal, state and local funding sources combined with outdated funding methods have impacted SMART causing a deficit in the tens of millions of dollars.

In order to achieve a balanced budget in 2009 and 2010, SMART has achieved \$7 million in savings through concessions, facility closures, elimination of operational expenses, bringing programs in-house and consolidating programs.

The SMART Board of Directors has authorized public hearings to discuss a fare increase on both Fixed Route and Connector service.
