Transfer Policy

Under the new transfer policy, regular fare transfers issued on a route cannot be used on that same route in the opposite direction.

The new transfer policy aligns the SMART Same Route, Different Direction (SRDD) transfer policy with other urban transportation systems in Michigan including Ann Arbor, DDOT and Grand Rapids. The purpose of a transfer ticket is to allow riders to reach a destination by using more than one bus. It is not intended for round trip travel.
