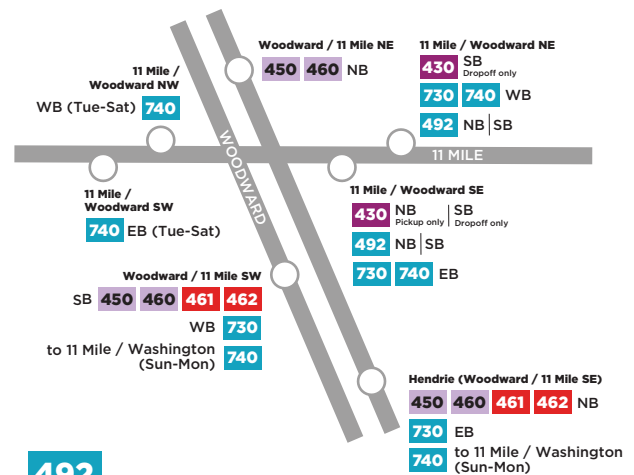

North Corral (Washington & Second)
Space for 1,000 bikes

South Corral (Washington & Lincoln)
Space for 800 bikes

First come, first served.
