Wayne County Transit Millage: Proposed Routes

Public transit is on the ballot on **Tuesday, August 4, 2026.**

Who is SMART?

Suburban Mobility Authority for Regional Transportation (SMART) is the public transit provider serving communities across Wayne, Oakland and Macomb Counties.

Who uses SMART?

A parent getting to a shift on time. A senior getting to medical appointments and grocery stores. A student getting to class or job training. A sports fan getting to a Tigers game.

What is a transit millage?

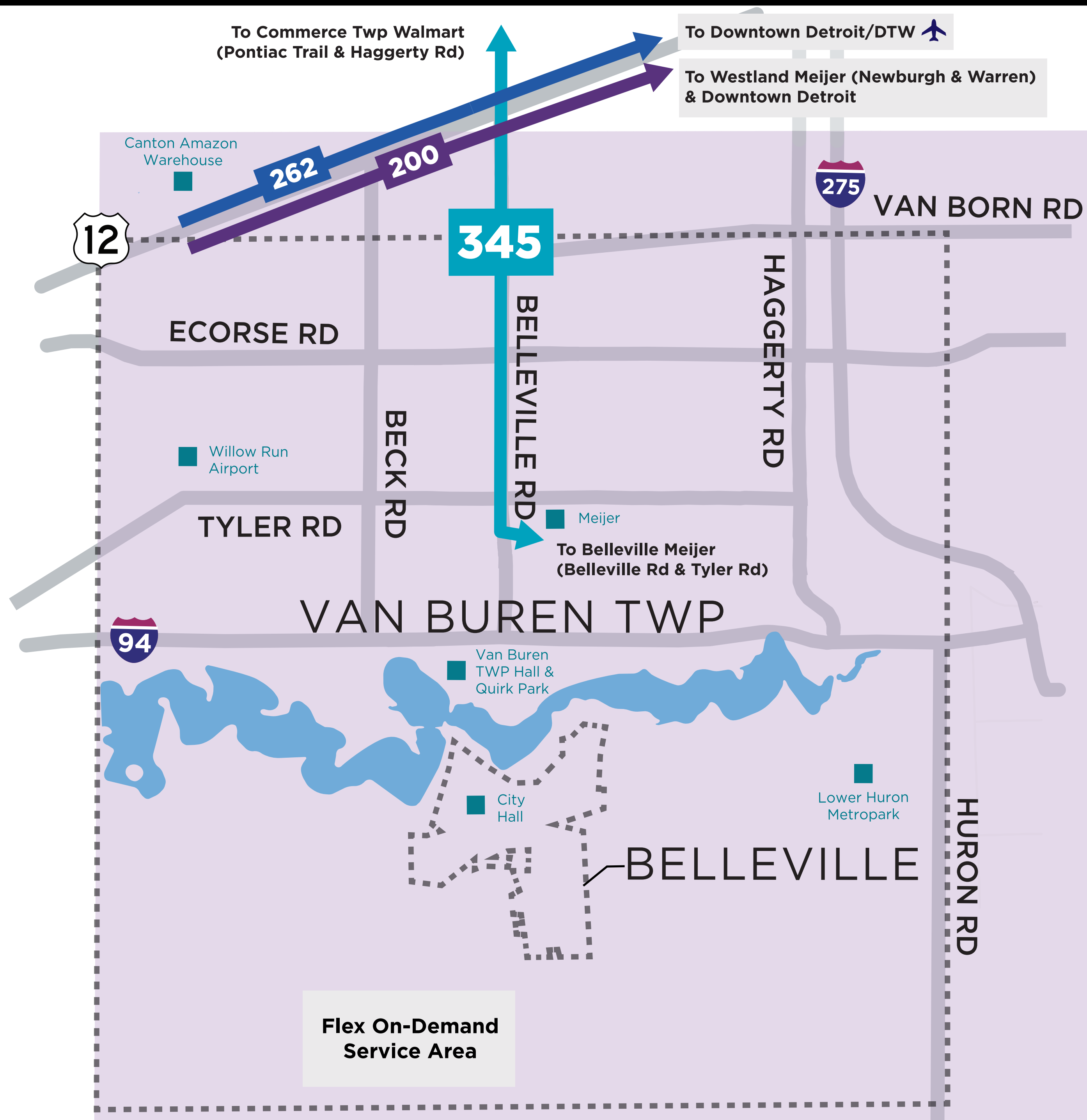
A property tax that funds public transportation. About \$8/month for a typical \$200,000 home.

What would the millage support?

A new Wayne County transit millage would provide about \$50 million annually over 10 years to fund bus service, on-demand transit, and community transit providers.

What does this map show?

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Route Clarification

Routes 261/262 and 200/210 are existing routes proposed for extension into Van Buren Township and do not extend into Belleville. Route 262 connects to Route 261 at Merriman Road, providing access to DTW.

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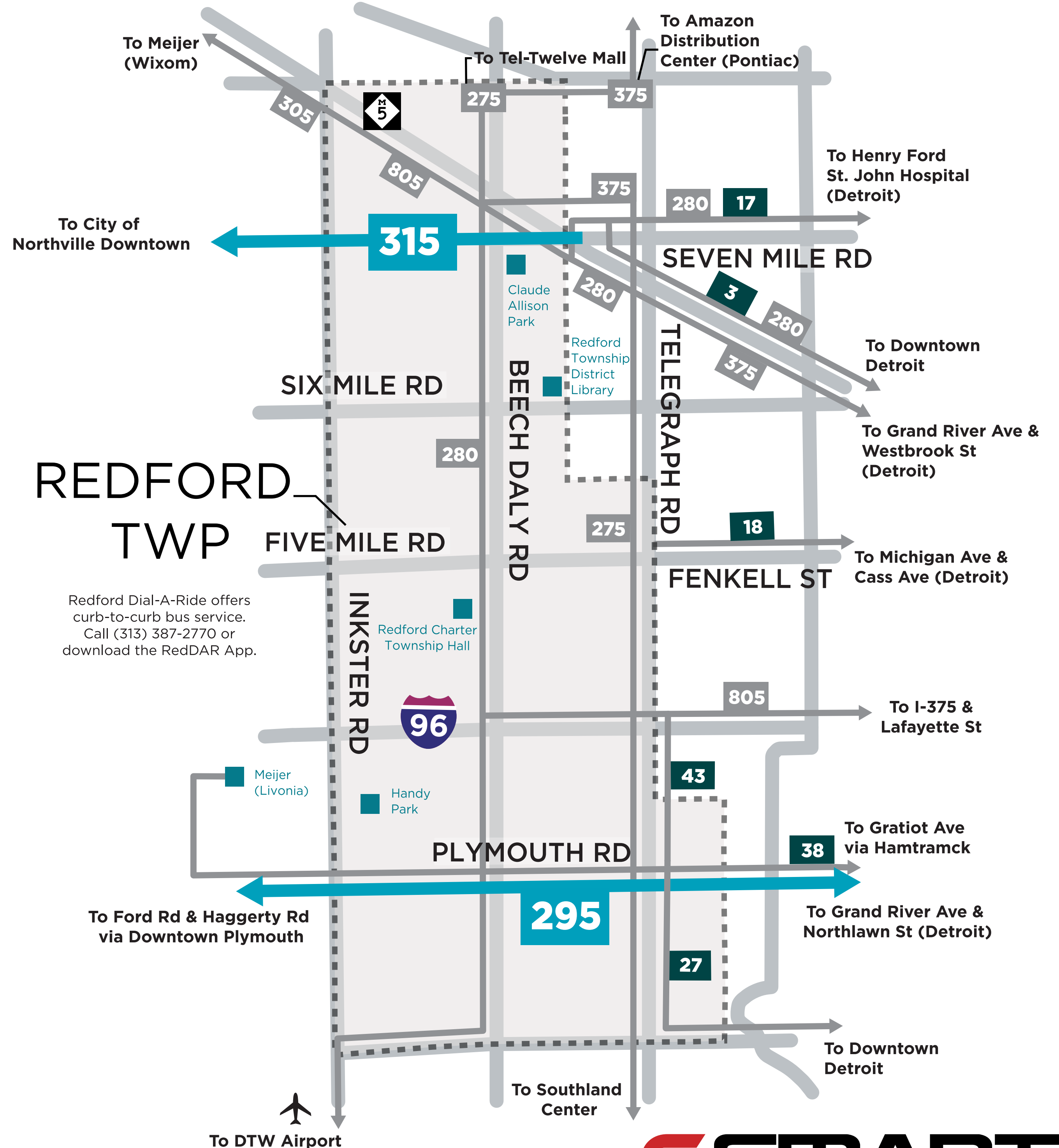
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Route Clarification

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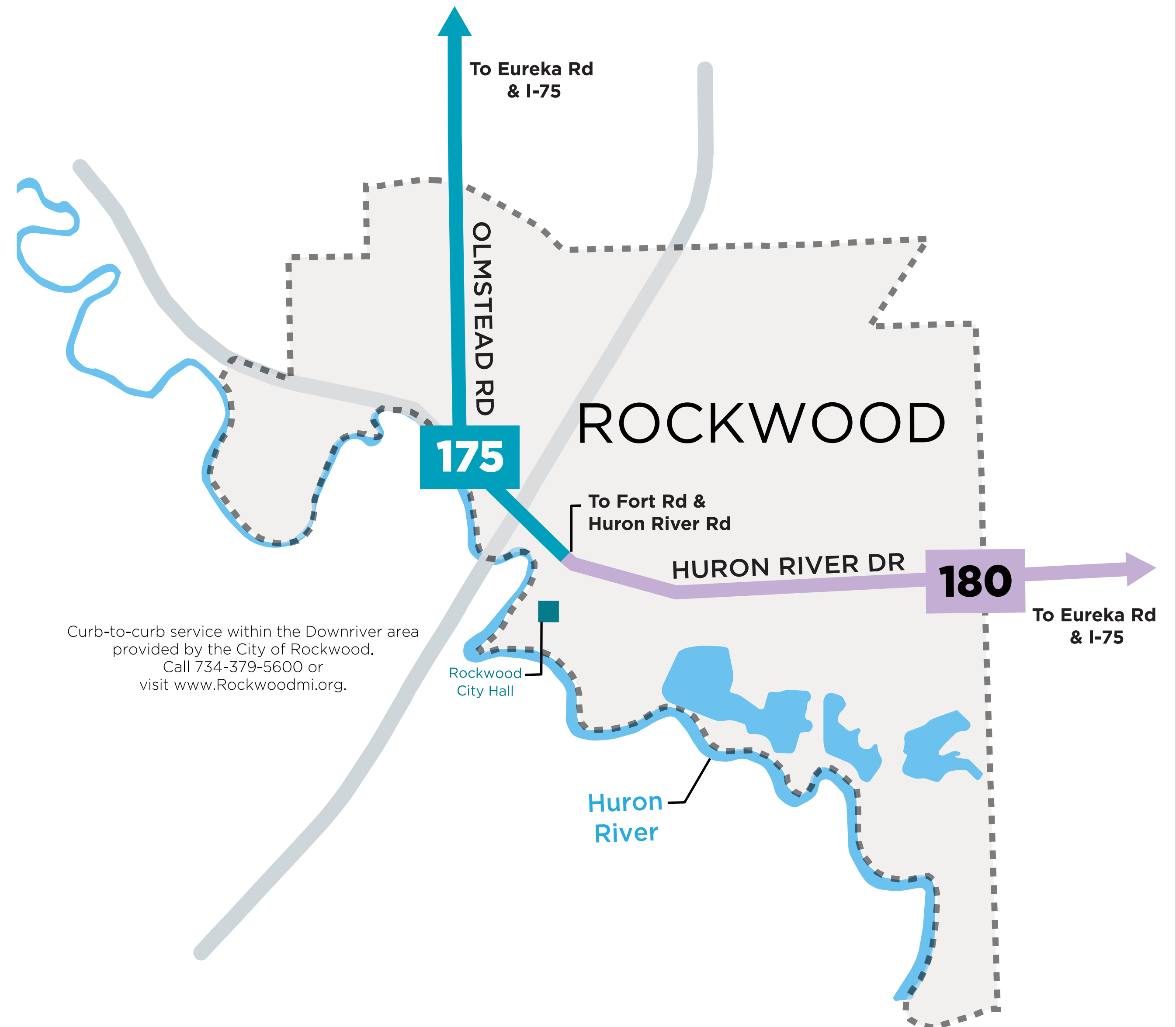

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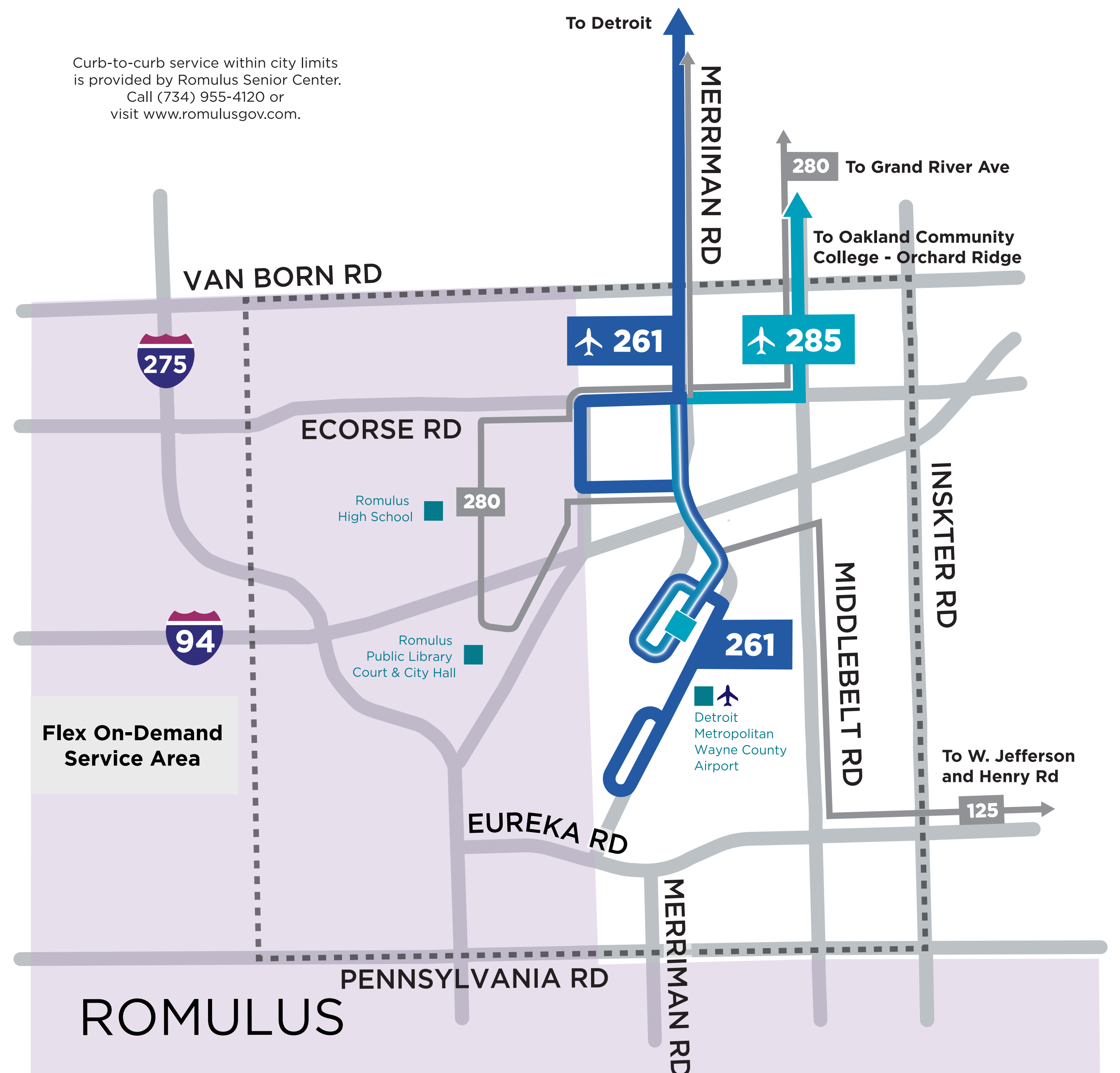
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Route Clarification

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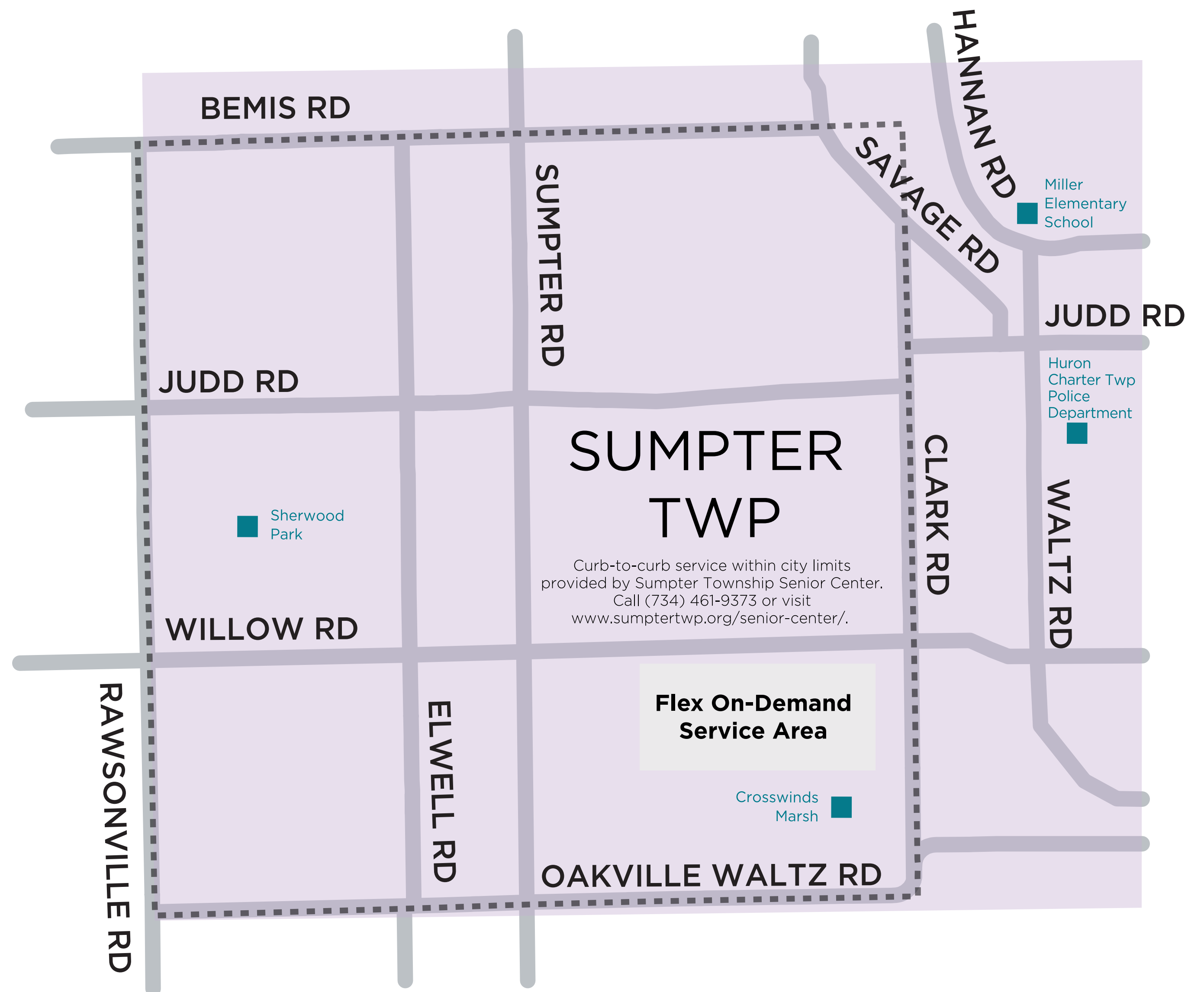
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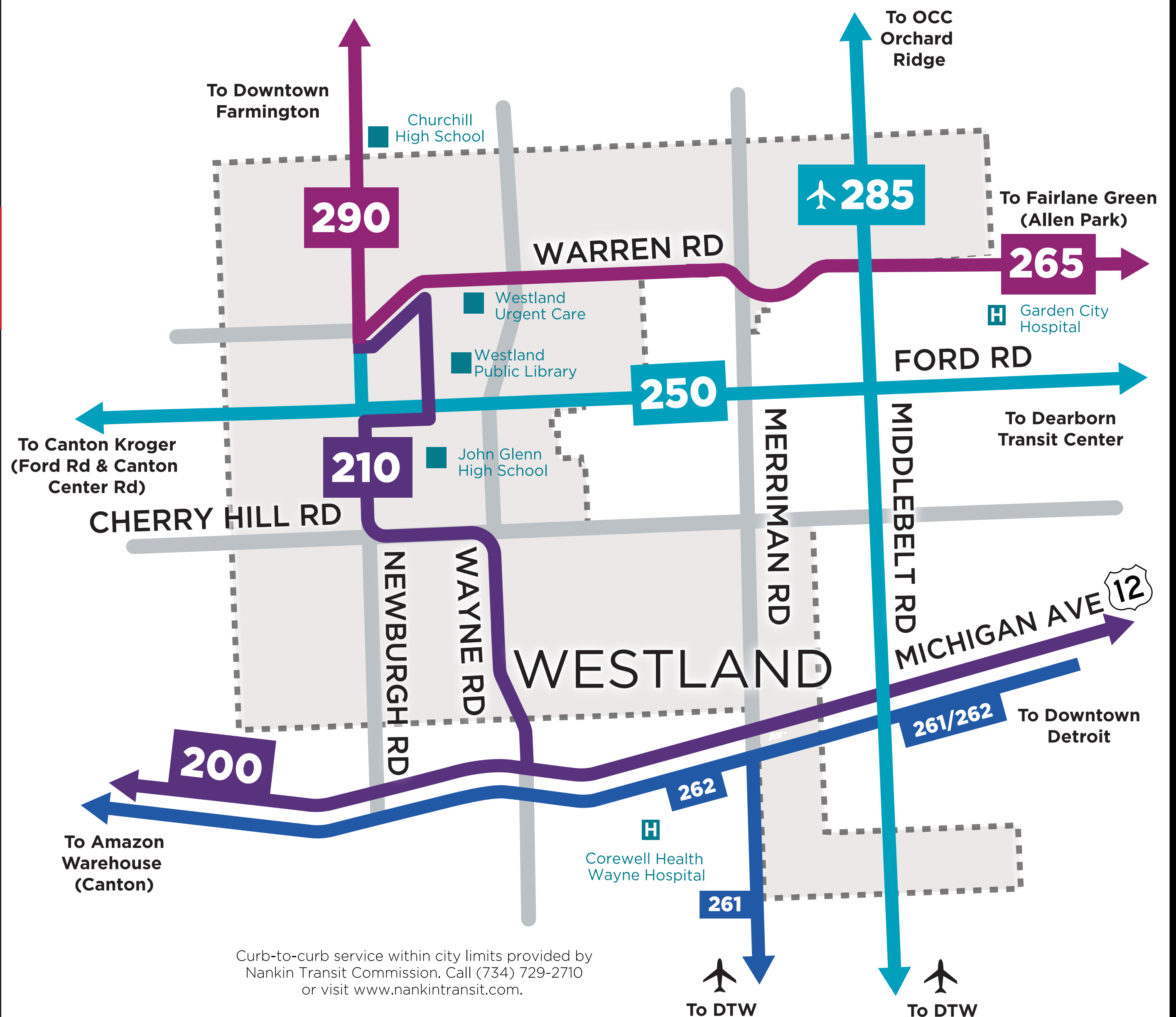
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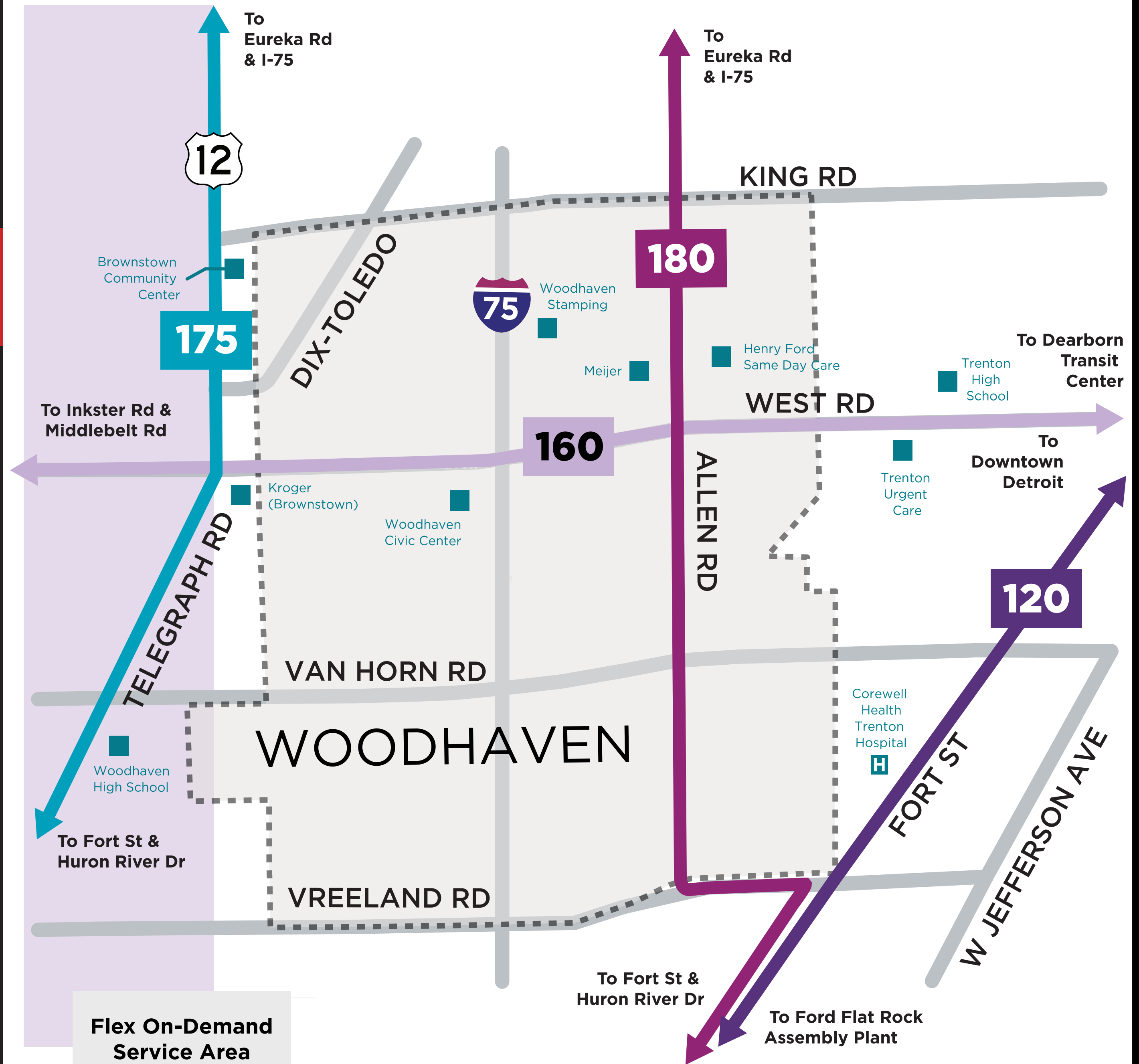
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
