Oakland County Michigan Works! staff will be there to help clear roadblocks that stand in the way of employment. They'll have information on a variety of programs including CDL training and licensing, free legal assistance programs for people eligible for conviction expungement, and support services for veterans, immigrants, refugees and other job seekers.
