
2026 Service Changes Systemwide Map





NEW! Route 100: Hamtramck


- Hourly service operating from 6am-12am Monday-Saturday and 9am-5pm Sunday
- Connects downtown Detroit, DMC/Detroit VA, Hamtramck, and Bel Air Center





NEW! Route 120: Fort Street


- 5am-12am Monday-Friday,
 6am-12am Saturday and Sunday
- Every 30 minutes on weekdays from 6am to 7pm, hourly during off-peak and weekends
- Connects Detroit, Lincoln Park,
 Southgate, Riverview, and Trenton
- Number change from 162 to 120
 Route will launch with local stop spacing outside Detroit





NEW! Route 750: Wixom


- 6am-11pm Monday-Friday, 8am-8pm Saturday, and 9am-5pm Sunday
- Hourly service
- Connects downtown Wixom and other commercial destinations to existing service on Grand River





261: FAST Michigan

 Weekday frequency will improve to every 20 minutes






461/462: *FAST* Woodward

- Weekday frequency will improve to every 20 minutes combined between Birmingham and Detroit
- North of Birmingham, each branch will arrive every 40 minutes






561: FAST Gratiot

- Route 563 will become Route 561 for consistent corridor numbering
- Weekday frequency will improve to every 20 minutes
- Route 562 will be eliminated

Routing Changes in Oakland County

430 Main Street

Extended north via Crooks and Auburn to connect with Route 790 at Adams Road Meijer & Walmart


494 Dequindre

Extended north via Dequindre and Auburn to connect with Route 492 at Rochester & Auburn

796 Perry-Opdyke

Service will be eliminated

Public input highlighted low ridership, redundant coverage

Schematic diagram. Not all stops are shown.


610 Kercheval-Harper

Extension north from Harper & 15 Mile to Mount Clemens and North River P&R via **Shook, Jefferson, and Crocker**

• In a later phase of SMARTer Network changes beyond 2026, service will extend south into downtown Detroit

780 Fifteen Mile Crosstown

Extension east from Gratiot to Harper to cover service removed from Route 610





Additional Fixed Route Changes

250 Ford Road

- Weekday frequency will improve to every 30 minutes
- Saturday service will be added

255 Ford Road Express

Service will be eliminated

305 Grand River

New 11:00pm departures in each direction

510/515 Van Dyke Locals

Extension to downtown Detroit via Van Dyke and Gratiot

- Lakeside Circle branch will remain Route 510
- Shelby Walmart branch will become Route 515

710 Nine Mile Crosstown

Weekday frequency will improve to **every 30 minutes**



SMART Flex Expansion

SMART Flex grows from **5 zones to 10** in 2026:

- Pontiac/Auburn Hills
- Troy/Clawson
- Farmington/Farmington Hills
- Bloomfield
- Rochester Hills (operated by Older Persons' Commission)
- East Hall Road
- West Hall Road
- Macomb (operated by Richmond / Lenox EMS)
- Dearborn
- Downriver

Distance cap

Flex is designed for shorter trips. A distance cap will increase efficiency and allow for a greater number of trips.

On-demand service

The option to prebook rides will be removed from the service due to the high number of late cancellation and no-show rates. This will allow for a more efficient on-demand experience.





What's Next?

We will implement these service changes on a **quarterly basis** with enhancements taking effect in January, April, June, and September. The first changes will go live on **Monday, January 5th.**
